Replacement Lens for non-SunWave™ Skylight and Smoke Vent with “Screw On” type lens design.

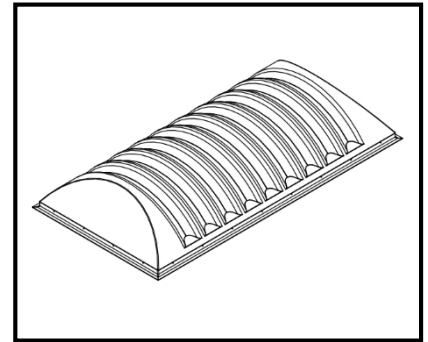

### Product Information

**Description:**

The SunWave™ replacement lenses are constructed using CC1 rated Polycarbonate Prismatic sheet. This lens option is intended for units using a design method that attaches the skylight lens, using pass-through holes, in the lens as an attachment point. Not intended for Framed SunWave™ products.

**Method of Application:**

1. Install in accordance with current Firestone specification, details and, workmanship requirements.

**Storage:**

- Store products in manufacturer's unopened packaging until ready for installation
- Store materials in a way that protects it from freezing, staining, contamination or, damage.

**Clean-Up:**

- Frequency of cleaning is determined by site conditions. When cleaning acrylic lenses, use only water or water with a mild soap. Use a soft rag to minimize scratching. A pressure washer is acceptable to use as well.
- Never use ammonia, aromatic or petroleum based products to clean lenses. This will cause deterioration and cracking of the lens and will void the warranty.

**Precautions:**

- Skylights not for use in Harsh, Corrosive, Marine and high-humidity Environmental Conditions such as Marina, Greenhouses, Petrol-Chemical facilities or other chemicals where the skylights may be exposed to such conditions.
- Certain airborne contaminants can diminish the integrity of acrylic and/or polycarbonate lenses.
- The installer shall be responsible for fall protection.
- Skylights should not be installed in locations with an operating temperature in excess of -75° F or 180°F.
